

## 25 TRAINING OBJECTIVES FOR DISCIPLESHIP

### 15. The Lordship of Christ

- *Truth to Teach:* When we trust Jesus to save us from our sins, we surrender our lives to follow Him as our Lord and King. Because Jesus is Lord of our lives, we repent of our sins and we obey Him with all of our hearts.

- *Scriptures:* **Romans 10:9-10** > What does it mean to confess Jesus as Lord?

What are the consequences of such a claim?

What does that compare Him to?

**Luke 9:57-62** > In this passage we see three men who could have been disciples. Why did each of them not ultimately follow Christ?

What are the costs of following Jesus? Why are there costs in following Jesus? Who is not fit for the Kingdom of God?

- *Application:* List some ways you can obey Jesus as Lord and King in your daily life.
- *Activities:* Make a list of some of the things in our lives that change when we become a Christian.
- *Practice:* What would help you this week to remember your loyalty to Christ?
