

25 TRAINING OBJECTIVES FOR DISCIPLESHIP

24. Sharing the Gospel

- *Truth to Teach:* Jesus commands us to share the Gospel with other people so that they will place their faith in Him. When we share the Gospel, we share about five main truths: (1) the character of God; (2) the sinfulness of man; (3) the gift of Christ; (4) the necessity of faith; and (5) the urgency of eternity. The Holy Spirit gives each of us power to share the Gospel and lead others to salvation in Christ.

- *Scriptures:* **Philemon 1:6** > What was Paul encouraging Philemon to do? Why did he desire Philemon to do this? What is the result of sharing your faith?

Acts 1:8 > What did Jesus promise His disciples? Are we promised this as well?

What will we do when the Spirit leads us? Where will we do this? What are our Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria and Ends of the Earth?

1 Peter 3:15 > What does Peter challenge us to do? How? Why?

- *Application:* Can you share the gospel with at least one person this week...with three people this week?
- *Activities:* We will engage in an activity together to demonstrate how to share the Gospel for the first time. Your teacher will go first, then you will have the opportunity to share. Make sure that you communicate each of the five truths mentioned above somehow in your presentation of the Gospel. It may help to teach them verses from Scripture that illustrate these truths.
- *Practice:* What steps can you take to be actively involved in telling others about Christ?
